Organization of the School Board
Board Committees

The board of education shall always act as a whole. There shall be no standing committees appointed which carry over into successive years. The president of the board of education may appoint special committees to perform some particular duty or responsibility. A special committee will cease to function when its duty has been performed or at the end of the fiscal year. The president may annually appoint during the August board meeting, such special board committees as The Committee on American Civics, Building and Grounds, Budget, Accreditation, Policy, Legislative Relations Network, and Negotiations.
