To be eligible to participate in any extra-curricular activity, a student in grades 7 through 12 must not be failing in two (2) or more classes. To be eligible to participate in activities, students must be taking two classes offered and taught by O'Neill High School staff. The remaining classes may come from another accredited institute after prior approval by the O'Neill guidance staff and high school principal. If a student does not maintain the above minimum standard, he/she will not be allowed to participate in any extra-curricular activity until the following Monday, providing the minimum standard is met. Each student may continue to participate in the training programs, but will not be eligible to take part in interschool activities or public performances during the period of ineligibility. This incentive is not cumulative. It is a week by week standard, with the first eligibility check occurring the Monday following Labor Day for the first semester and the last Monday in January for second semester. Incompletes will be treated as a failing grade. The administration reserves the option to rule on special situations.
