Section 600 – Instruction Academic Achievement Student Honors and Awards

The school district shall provide a program that establishes honors and awards including, but not limited to, academic letters, scholarships and good citizenship awards for students to assist them in setting goals. Students shall be made aware of honors and awards and the action necessary on the part of the student to achieve them. <u>Students who have not attended the school district for their entire high school education or have not attended an accredited public or private school will not be eligible for some honors and awards.</u>

Students enrolled on a part-time basis will not be eligible to graduate or receive a diploma from the district or receive academic honor distinctions including: Honor Roll eligibility, Outstanding Student Awards, National Honor Society membership, Academic Athlete Award or Academic Activity Award.

Students enrolled on a part-time basis will be eligible to receive honors awarded for the activity through the school, conference, or state including: Team Captain, awarding of Activity Letters, 3-D Award, All-Conference and All-State awards. Part-time students will not be eligible to receive Athlete of the Year Award or Spirit Award.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to implement this policy.
