Facility slideshow: This assignment is designed to get the students active in looking at several medical facilities and pick one that interests them the most. Then the students will put the most important information into a slideshow that highlights the facility and could be used to describe the services provided.

-Insurance information and how it applies. PPO, HMO, etc.

-Career overviews on therapeutic medicine and careers, diagnostic medicine and careers, and the informational and financial sections of medical professions.

-Hospital tours of our local facility.

Main objective: Medical Terminology

Northeast Community College credit via their outreach program to help students better understand terminology before getting into the college setting.

The students work primarily on the suffixes, prefixes, and putting entire words together.

Pronunciation is also key.

The students will use a workbook that guides them through the entire medical terminology and has areas to stop and use those terms in real life scenarios, games, and projects throughout the year.
