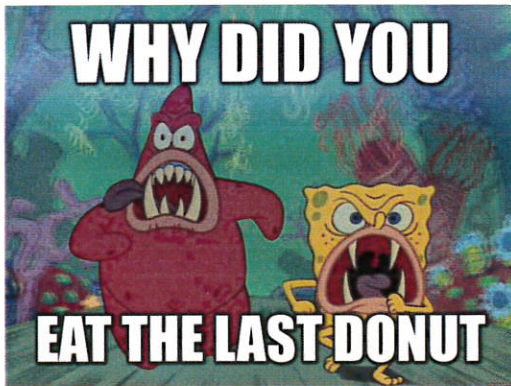
Elementary News
