Welcome back from the holiday break. We hope everyone had a wonderful time with family and friends and enjoyed the holidays.

A couple items that are some subtle changes for the remainder of the school year. We have new co-directors of our Developing Eagles after school program. The directors are Barb McCain and Deb Sawyer. These ladies will be guiding this program as we continue to move forward.

One change that has been implemented for the remainder of the school year and moving forward is that students will need to be physically checked out of the Developing Eagles Program by an authorized person kept on file with the Developing Eagles staff. We will not release a student if someone calls the office and asks for a student to be sent out of the building to a waiting ride. For student safety reasons we will require an approved person to physically enter the building to check their student out of Developing Eagles.

The building staff met during our inservice day and we have new behavioral goals for the students for the 3rd Quarter. We would like to share that we have set two goals for our students for improvement. We are looking to improve our behavior in the environments of the classroom and the playground. We have also set a goal of our students earning 1,000 Eagle Earnings . These Eagle Earnings are our way of recognizing our students for what they are doing well at the school.
