Student Activities
Student Activity Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in any extra-curricular activity, a student in grades 9 through 12 must be passing in five (5) classes for each quarter. Two of these classes must be offered and taught by O’Neill High School staff. The remaining three classes may come from another accredited institute after prior approval by the O’Neill guidance staff and high school principal. A student in grades 7 through 8 must be passing in four (4) subjects, of which three (3) are core classes. If a student does not maintain the above minimum standard, he/she will not be allowed to participate in any extra-curricular activity until the next quarter, providing the minimum standard is met. Each student may continue to participate in the training programs, but will not be eligible to take part in interschool activities or public performances during the period of ineligibility. This incentive is not cumulative. It is a quarter by quarter standard. Incompletes will be treated as a failing grade. The administration reserves the option to rule on special situations.
