Coaches: We will attempt to stay on time. Please report to the site at least 20 minutes prior to the starting time of each game. Failure to report to the game on time will result in forfeit for your team. Please note that this is a very tight schedule, and we are determined to start every game on time. This will be rolling schedule. (If we are ahead of schedule we will not slow down).

Game Rules:

- 1. 14-minute running clock per half. Clock will stop only the last minute of each half and at free throws.
- 2. Warm-up time if time allows. (5-10 minutes possible)
- 3. 3-minute halftime
- 4. 1 timeout per half. One additional if OT occurs.
- 5. Home team will be on the top of the bracket, or first team listed
- 6. Home team will be the light uniform
- 7. Home team will be the official book
- 8. 7th & 8th Grade may do a full court press to a 15-point lead, 5th & 6th Grade may full court press the last minute of each half, 3rd & 4th grade can NOT full court press, and can man-to-man after the half court line.
- 9. Overtime, if needed, will be 2 minutes in length, 2nd overtime is sudden death
- 10 . Teams are responsible of their own belongings
- 11 Each team must furnish a scorekeeper, with a scorebook
- 12 Players may play in only one division and on one team, unless ok'd by meet directors
- 13 Players earning a technical foul for the lack of sportsmanship will sit out of the remainder of that game, and may be subject to be ejected from the tournament.
- 14 Any person who displays negative interaction towards other teams, officials, or volunteers can result in the removal from the tournament with no refund.
- 15 Rules may change during tournament time at the discretion of the tournament directors.
